Projections for 2024

Different Scenarios based on what % of Priest POP carries Since probably unlikely that we will have a priest in 2023, we will have a surplus

Plus, with a Priest want major rent costs we'll have 90% of budget committed Current status with St Thomas: to be discussed

QUESTION- Can we afford to stay where we are <u>and</u> have a priest?

depends on medical costs, % of carried by St Thomas and rent charges

Can we afford rent where we are?

APPROACHES:

If we run a deficit in 2024, would the Diocese step in for 2025?

If we use a portion of our '23 surplus we could potentially afford a 2-year lease with Peace Lutheran with a "small" increase

QUESTIONS

Does Peace Lutheran want us to continue as Lessees?

*NOTE: They are looking at major building renovation/repair, so unable to afford a <u>Vicar</u> <u>for a year.</u>

<u>IDEA-</u>Look at grants to assist us in our building efforts.

Maybe combine that with Diocesan support

Look for resources in our congregation (Nancy, Char)

Communication w/ Diocese (% Chris Craun)

- 1. Issue of Facilitator in hands of Bishop
- 2. Tower Lease Renewal:

Diocese suggests we decide property plans before long term commitment Diocesan Chancellor is supposed to negotiate for us

Sense that the Diocese right now is not in a position to respond effectively

TO DO's:

Nancy will check with Diocese re: the above.

Nancy will let Cell Tower Co. know of our interest in continuing to extend our lease

Re: Clergy

Last candidate suggested as not being a good "fit"

There may be ministers from other compatible-denominations and/or rotating or visiting Priests (e.g., Charlie Floes: interim with St Barnabas/McMinnville;

Rev. Carr) Also continuing to use the Rev. Linda Wood;

Mary Macy will do the Financials re: costs of increasing supply clergy

CHURCH HOME:

Need to find out what Peace Lutheran's needs and intentions

Bill is willing to work as a part of the process --

Should we

-approach them softly (to bridge build) to assess "where they are"?

-let them just know the maximum we can afford?

Majority of the BAC feels it would not be helpful to try to discuss per se but rather let them know what we can do=bottom line.

Related Issue: How to balance the issue of getting a Priest as it relates to how much rent we can afford? .

Felt need to get a decision from Peace Lutheran first.

To Do's

Mary Macy will work up scenarios re: how much rent we can afford and send to BAC members for comment

Nancy will use those figures in a letter requesting a response from Peace Lutheran by October 1st.
