# **Survey Discission (rental options)**

Began to discuss survey (3 more received and entered into database after email reminder today).

Sue discussed questions from Temple Beth Shalom (primarily about security issues and faith issues) with a follow-on meeting with Temple directors. No number yet on costs – know we need it by 15.<sup>th</sup>

Nancy thinking of contacting Bishop Prior but Mary thinks there is movement afoot with the developer in Atlanta (relative to exploring property development).

### Survey discussion (other comments):

In response to comment on need for connectivity, Sue mentioned the Arrowhead community room is available and that might be a venue for gathering the congregation and increasing connectivity.

Mary Macy indicated the need to engage with the Bishop prior to making a decision.

Concerns expressed about St. Paul's and our ability to maintain independence if we used chapel.

Intent is to discuss comments we received on survey with congregation (at coffee hour).

#### **Meeting minutes:**

Parishioner raised concerns about not having minutes on website. Official binders don't have minutes and need to be updated and minutes need to be signed to be official. Nancy will look at emailing out minutes versus posting them on website.

#### Moving preparations:
